## Become a Member

Members are granted access to the Makerspace according to their level of membership. Full members are given a card granting them access 24/7, to the space, the projects, and all of the tools. Basic members are welcome to come to the space and use the tools any time it is already open, and have the full experience and knowledge of our members at their disposal.

The starter membership allows access to the space for observation purposes only, and only when there are already members present.

We now have our 501(c)3 non-profit organization status (Sept, 2013), so all membership dues may be tax-deductible.

So what do you get if you join the Santa Barbara Makerspace? Lots! Access to the 3D printers in the space. Use of space for co-working. Many maker tools and electronic stuff is available. All ages are welcome, under 18's need to accompanied by an adult.
